Training nurses from Vietnam – Lessons from the pilot project in Germany

Summary:

Due to demographic ageing and a shrinking workforce Germany needs to pave new ways for creating a sustainable health workforce. Among the different measures, which have been started to reach this goal (more education, retention management etc.), the recruitment and education of candidates from third countries has been piloted in cooperation with Vietnam.

After a six month language course in Vietnam 100 candidates started a two-year training in elderly care in Germany. Through the pilot Germany gained experience with the integration of foreign nurses in the elderly care sector. In the future closer co-operations with Vietnamese nursing schools will be established.

Key subjects addressed: recruitment, elderly care, migration, education.
