## Some results from the WP5 survey

### Which professions are included in planning in MSs?

Which professions are included now?

PROFESSIONS INCLUDED	Number	%
All Professions	2	17%
All, except midwives	1	8%
Physicians, nurses and dentists	2	17%
Physicians, nurses and pharmacists	1	8%
Physicians and nurses	1	8%
Physicians and dentist	2	17%
Only physicians	3	25%
<b>Total</b>	<b>12</b>	<b>100%</b>

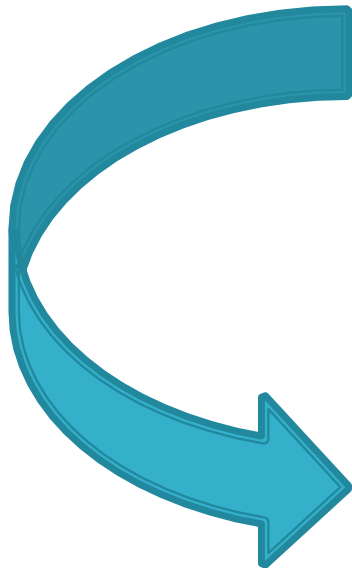

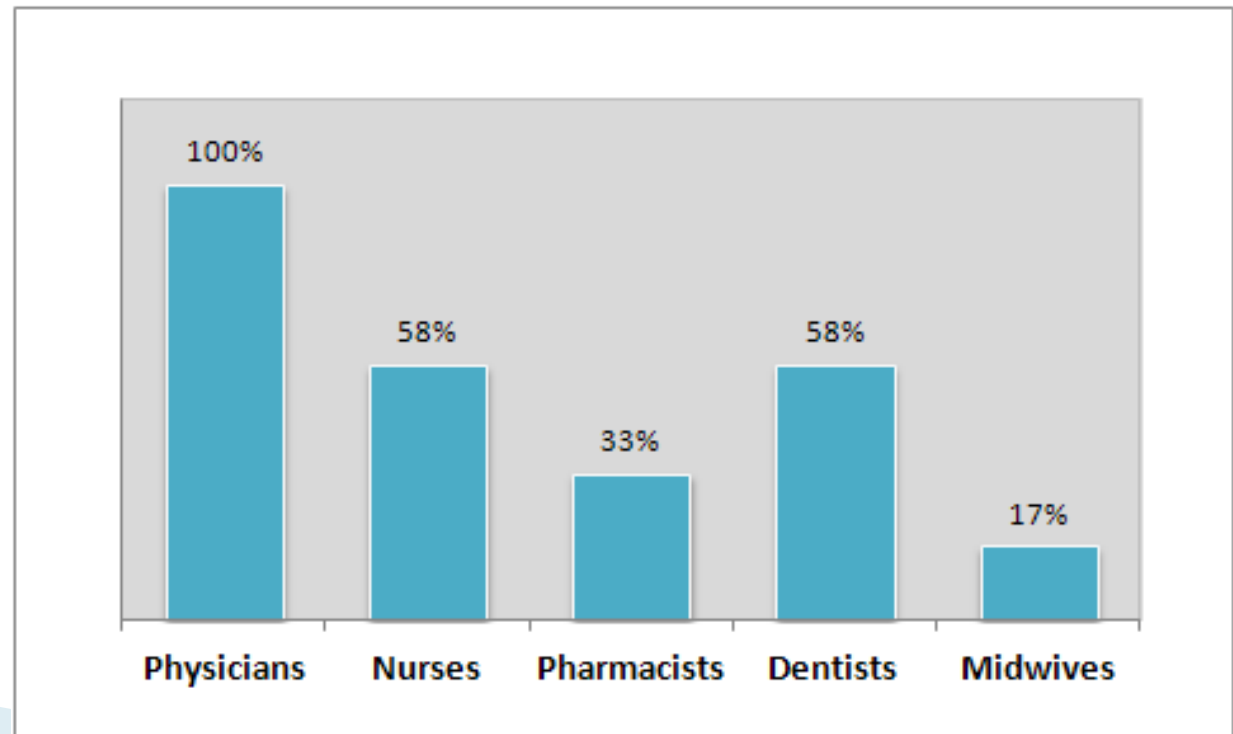


## In synthesis...

- ✓ every Country plans physicians
- ✓ only 2 Countries (on 12 analyzed) have a planning process for midwives
- ✓ Nurses and Dentists are included in more than half of totale MSs interviewed
- ✓ About 1 /3 of Countries include Pharmacists in planning

- ▶ All 5 professions
- ▶ Only physicians
- ▶ Physicians and nurses
- ▶ Physicians and dentists
- ▶ Physicians, nurses and dentists







## Minimum data set – how many?

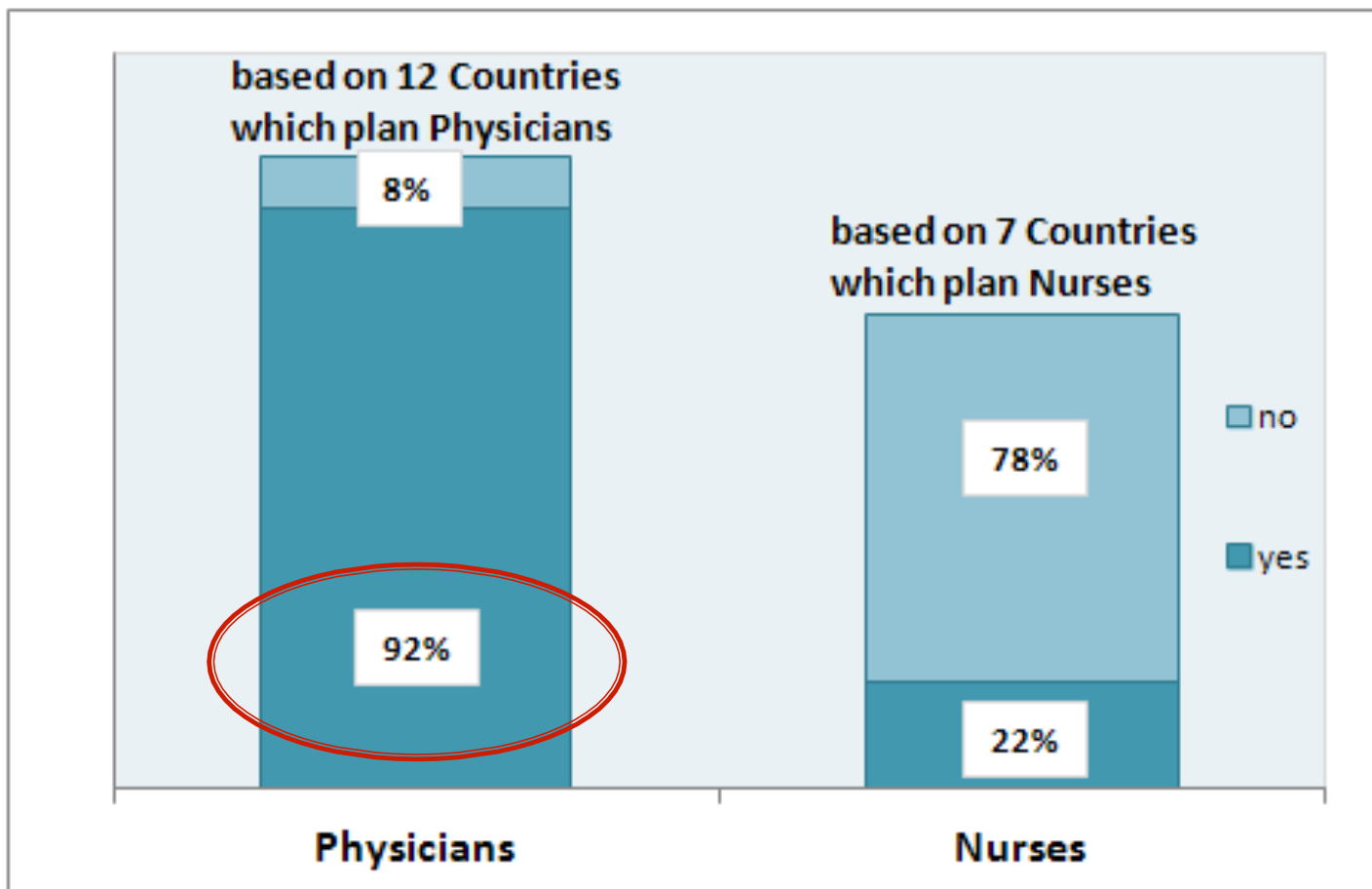
- ▶ One data set for each one
- ▶ A unique data set for all
- ▶ A specific data set only for physicians
- ▶ A specific data set for physicians and for nurses
- ▶ A specific data set for physicians and for dentists





# Minimum data set – which level of aggregation?

The planning is set for different types of physicians/nurses?

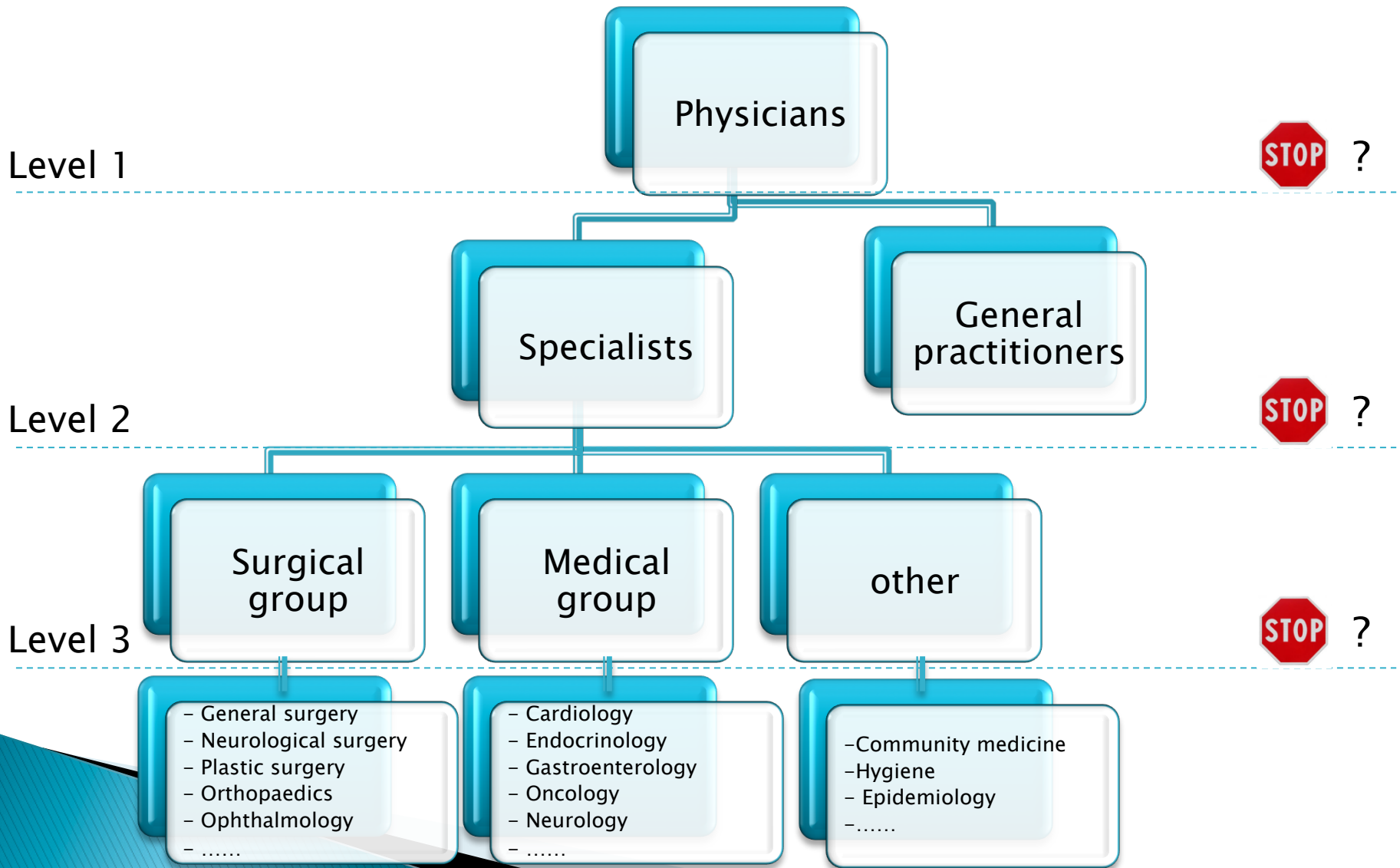
