Higher effectiveness:

- Better monitoring by access to timely data
- Increased quantitative and qualitative planning capacity
- Higher impact of HWF planning and forecasts on policy decision making





SPECIAL OBJECTIVES OF THIS EXPERTS CONFERENCE (1)

PART I – THE HANDBOOK

The Joint Action has the goal to collect **knowledge** and share it, highlighting the good practices. **The format is at least a handbook** and a web-portal.

A handbook is a collection of best practice than will NOT land on a shelve, but be:

- Used / implemented
- Updated
- Filled in
- Spread across EU

⇒ STRATEGIC OBJECTIVE:

- WP5 to build a handbook that supports the pilot implementation
- WP5 to build a handbook that supports future full country implementations





SPECIAL OBJECTIVES OF THIS EXPERTS CONFERENCE (2)

PART I – THE HANDBOOK

- ⇒ Conference STRATEGIC EXPECTATIONS :
 - COMPLETE: The Conference should collect most of the Best Practices in a comprehensive way
 - **INPUT**: The Conference should enable WP5 to start writing the text of the handbook in a way that makes chances to receive agreement.
 - The Conference must ensure that the input that will be in the handbook is **OF ADDED VALUE** to EU Member States.
 - The Conference must ensure that the selected best practice may soon be the one **TO TURN INTO PRACTICE WITHIN THE PILOT STUDIES**, and then after the Joint Action.

Complete input of added value to turn into practice within the pilot studies.





SPECIAL OBJECTIVES OF THIS EXPERTS CONFERENCE (3)

PART II – THE PILOT PROJECTS

⇒ Conference STRATEGIC EXPECTATIONS :

- The Conference should help Italy & Portugal to identify a feasible, yet ambitious, implementation scope of their pilot projects.
- The advise must help on the most critical elements, to help the choice to be made soon (ideally finalised in the meeting of Lisbon) in order to meet the planning
- Other non-planning countries present should benefit from the discussions to investigate with higher confidence potential medium to long term increase of planning capacity
