

### THE PROJECTS

- The Country projects could be broader than the Joint Action pilot project
- Still, the pilot projects must fully cover the Joint Action Grant Agreement Scope
- The Country projects are started before the Joint Action and will end later
- The Joint Action is an important opportunity, for receiving help, transfer knowledge, receive international labelling, overcome local historical blocking points, ...

=> We need to clearly present the various expected benefits & scopes





### PROJECT LIFECYCLE

Project Idea

- Draft description of the project
- Draft estimates of the Cost vs. Benefits



Project Business Case

- Full analysis of the Cost vs. Benefits
- Full analysis of the various options & choose of one



Project Brief

- Set up of the project team
- Full design of the plan and budget



Project Execution

- Start & Execution of the project
- Build of the products incl. Testing



Project Closure

- Evaluation of the benefits vs. Costs
- Lessons for future actions



#### **CURRENT ACTION:**

- Create a transparent objectives description
- Choice between the scope options to reach the objectives
- Evaluation the HR & High level plan to make it








Joint Action Health Workforce Planning and Forecasting




