








#### The total picture: MDs

Did your country supply data for these JQ categories in 2013?



#### **Quotes on categories**

Assistant professional nurse

"does not exist in **Belgium**"

"does not feature in the Irish Health Service"

"Poland does not indicate anything in this category"

"In the **Italian** regulatory system not covered"

"Nurses – Practising e.g. for **Scotland** 'Professional Nurses are categorised as those with Agenda for Change bands 5-9 and Associate professional nurses those with Agenda for Change bands 1-4."

"In **Greece**: Professionally Active Nurses are defined by qualifications under the 2005/36 directive only"





#### Quotes on categories 2.

Iceland reports the same numbers fot Practising and Professionally Active categories, because "no distinction can be made" "In Portugal: Professionally Active Midwives data supplied refer to nurses specialised in Maternal Health and Obstetrics."

" In **Spain**, the midwife is a category for nurses"


In **Italy**: "Except paediatric care nurse, it's important to note that in Italy there aren't additional specific qualifications for professional nurses"

"...nurse for the elderly is a completely different education path and therefore not included in the definition of nurses in **Germany**" "In **Finland** we use: Ward nurse (master degree), General regsitered nurse and within Health care assistants category we understand assistant nurses who do tasks that nurses won't do"





#### **Headcount vs. FTE - Possible formulas?**



Portugal: FTE using the real number of hours/week that a health professional does and we calculate a percentage of FTE (35H) or FTE (40H), depending on the established on the specific contract. If one works 20 hours/week we consider 0.5 FTC (40H).

- **Belgium**: FTE is defined using the median income of the age group 45-54 (self-employed/salaried different!)
- Germany: FTE is calculated by adding the full and appropriate proportion of part-time occupied employees
  - Finland: FTE= 1 \* head count of full time persons + 0,6 \* head count of part time persons + 0 \* head count of persons on leave


UK: 1 FTE is equivalent to 37.5 hours

**Iceland**: FTE is the equivalent of 167 workhours pr. month.

Hungary: the actually performed weekly working hours are divided by the weekly compulsory labour time (40 or 36 hours) as stipulated by the law for individual jobs

#### Information flow = Easy access?

Multiple actors in data reporting – Majority  $\rightarrow$  **YES**Is the Focal Point the organisation that has the data? – Most of the times  $\rightarrow$  **NO**

JQ categories correspond well to the national composition


JQ reporting raises no issues for the national data collection system
