- > **7,8%** of all the registered Doctors in France

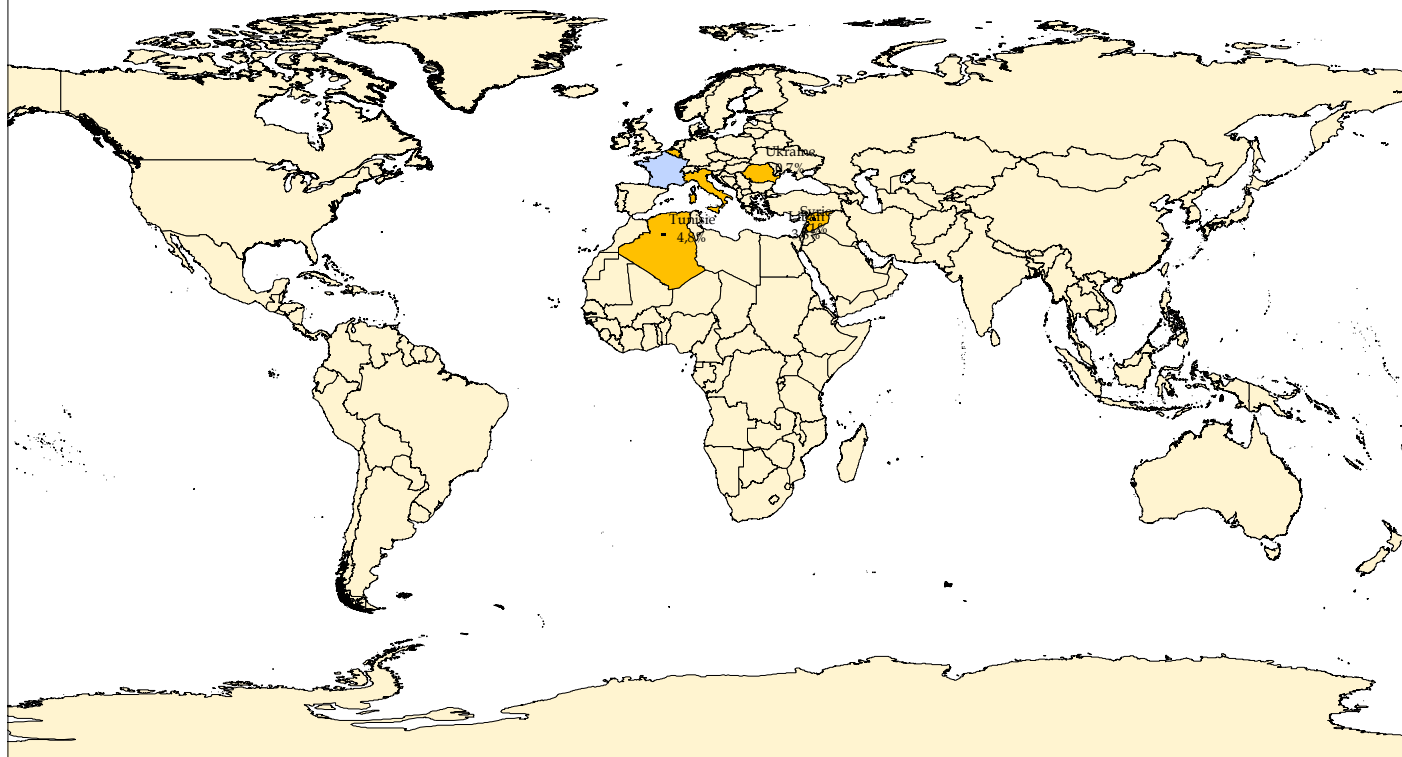
Origin of Non EU diploma

Active Doctors with a foreign diploma practising in France



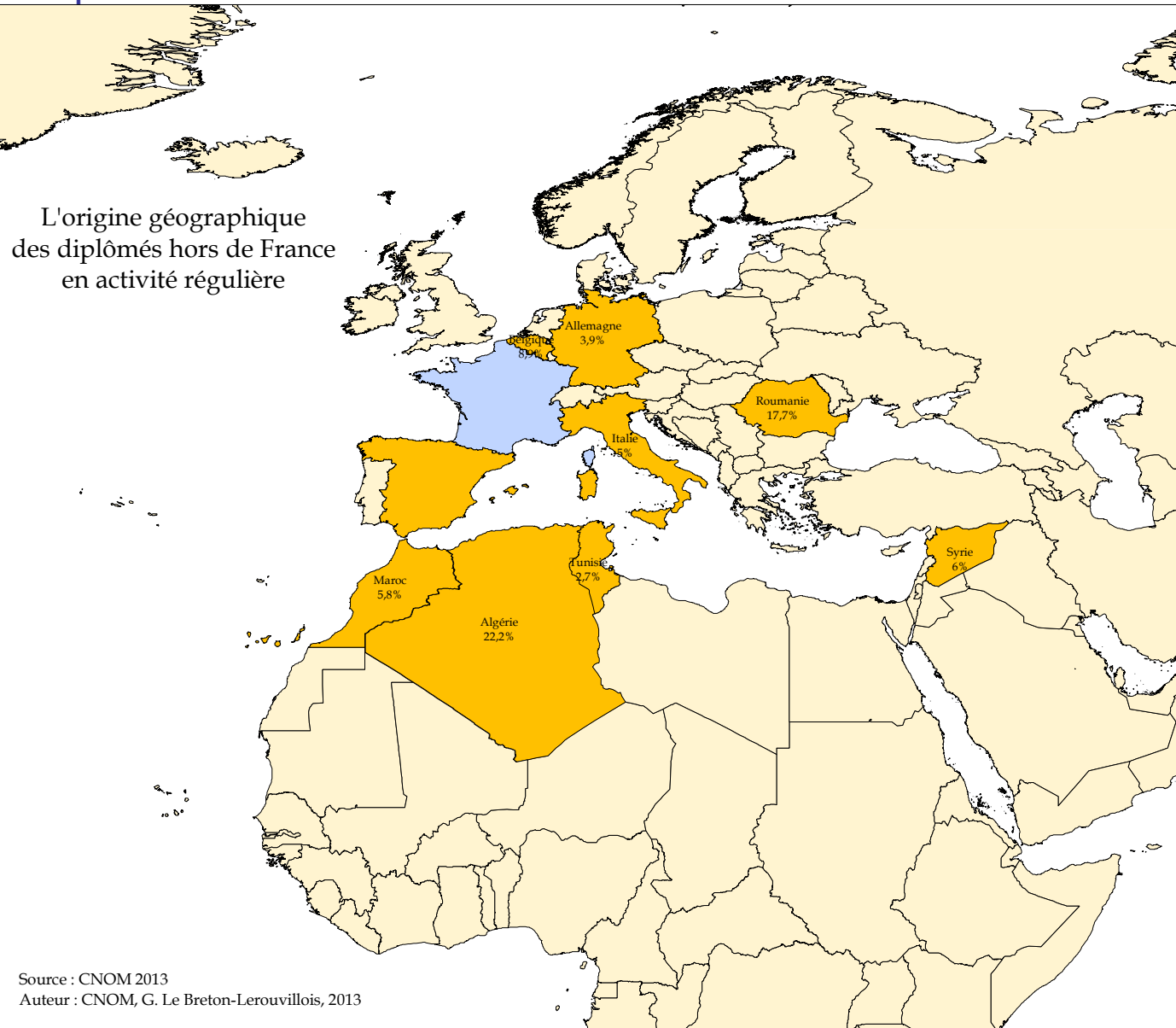
76,4% of these Doctors graduated in one of these 10 countries in the map :

-7958 hold a European degree

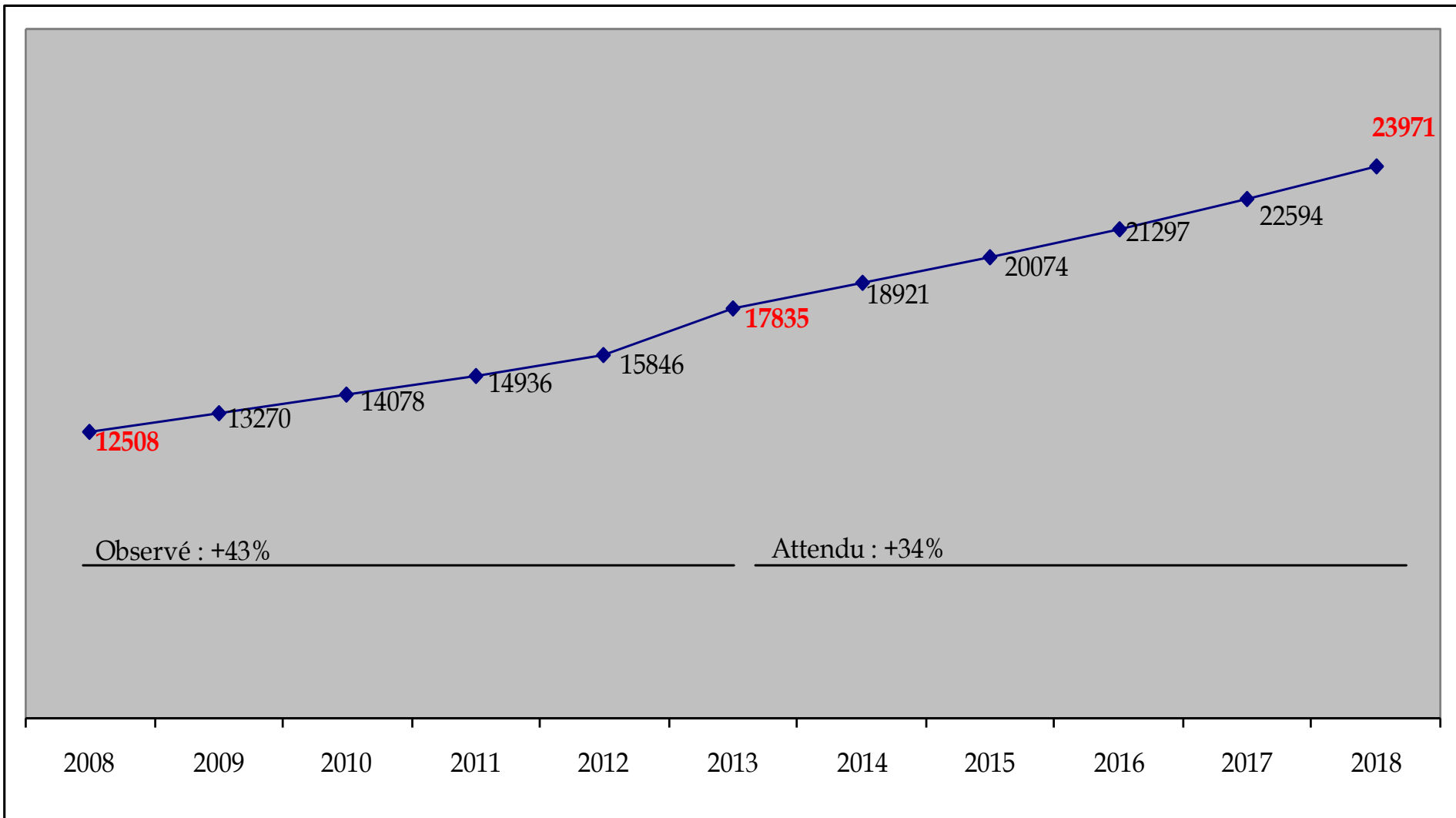
-9877 hold a non EU degree

-62% of them are men



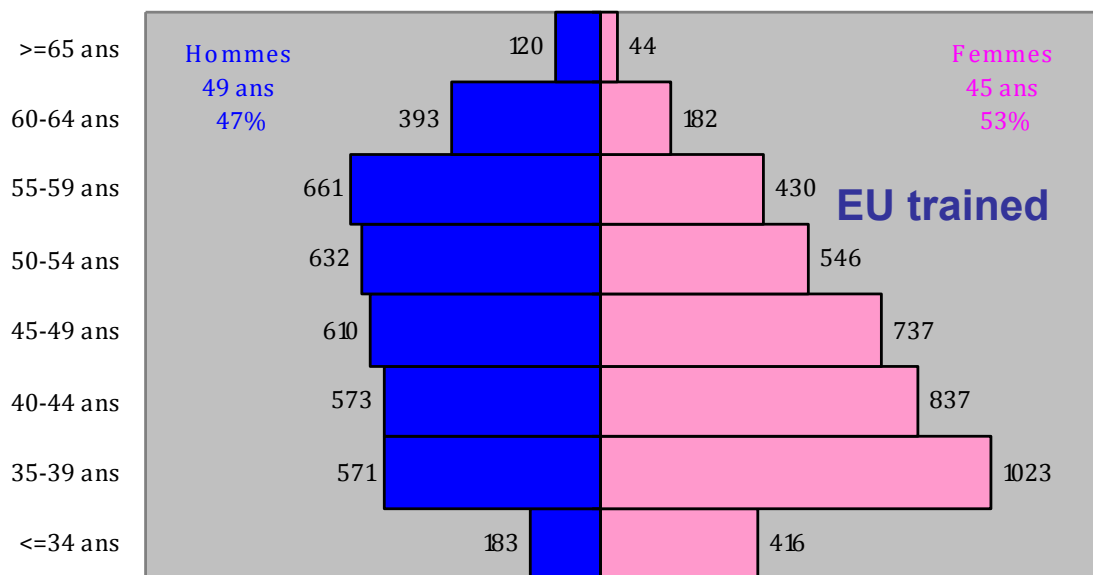


Workforce : from now to what is expected





❖ Gender distribution

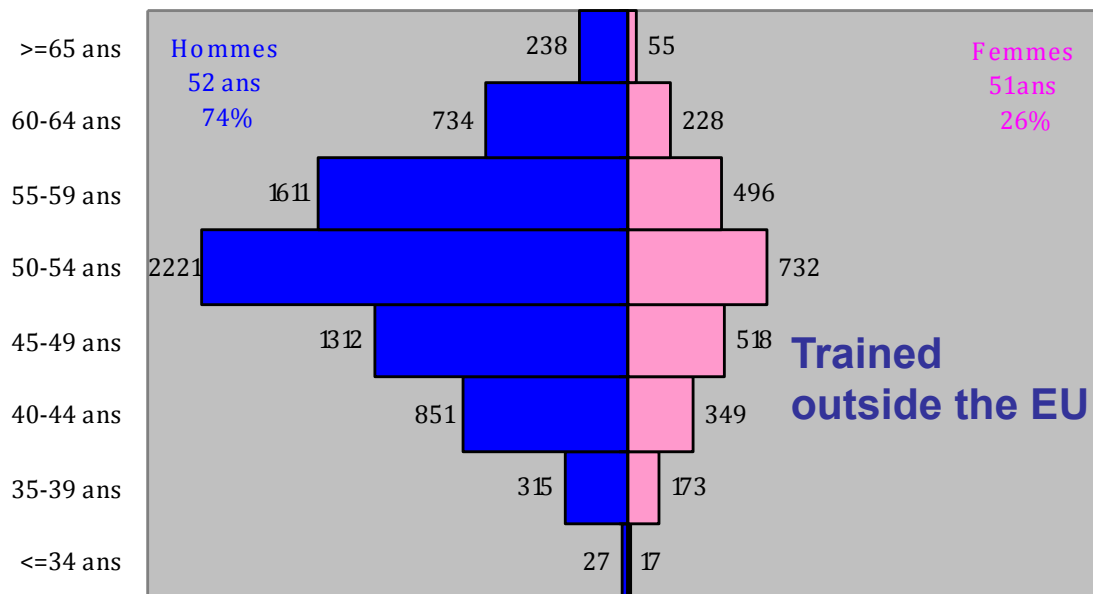


❖ Main attractive specialties in France for the newcomers:

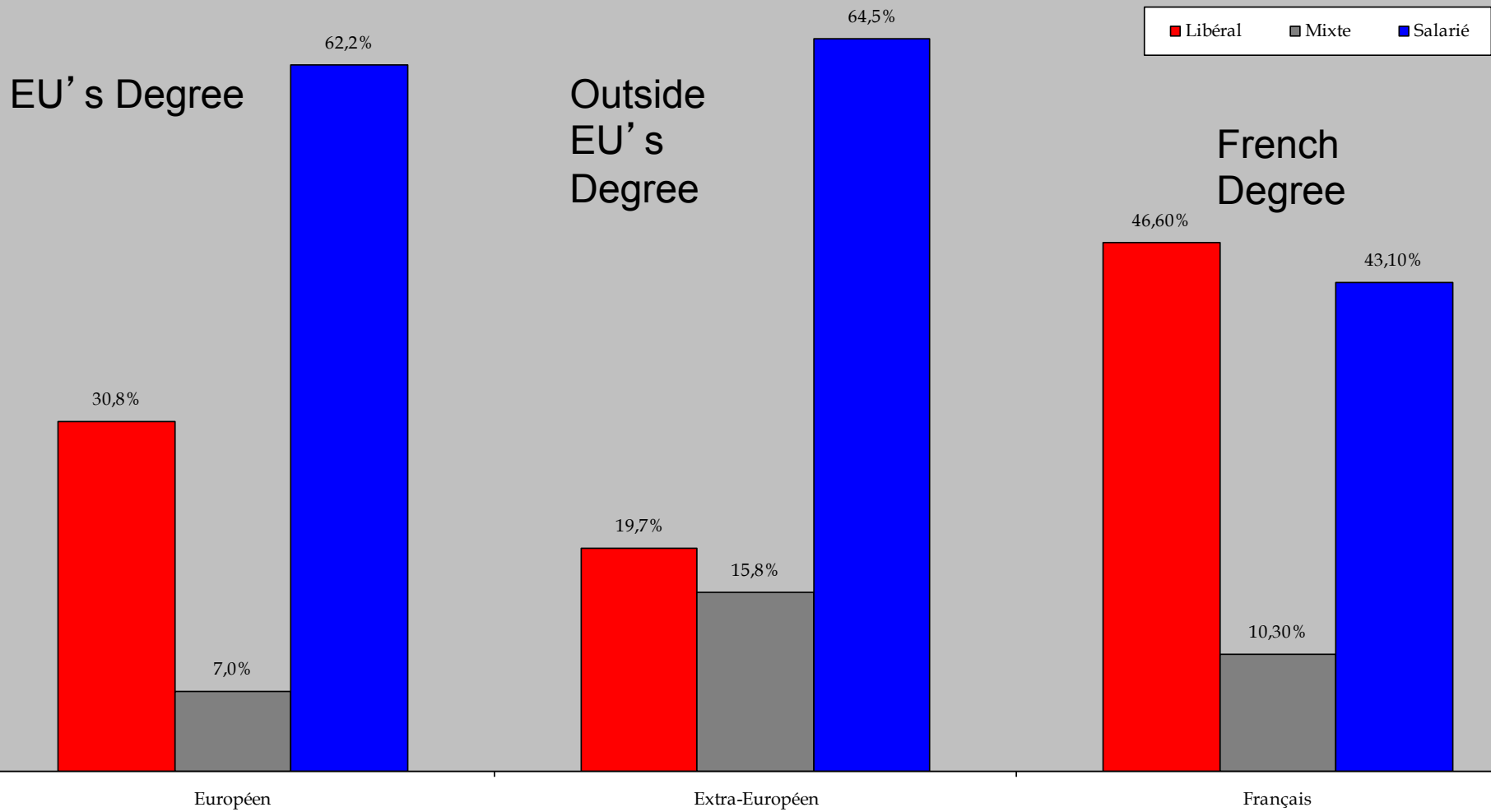
- Family physician
