Proxy measures of mobility

Examples of proxy measures of mobility using The Nursing and Midwifery Council Register:

Inflow

- the number of nurses newly registered in the UK
- measures intention and eligibility rather than employment

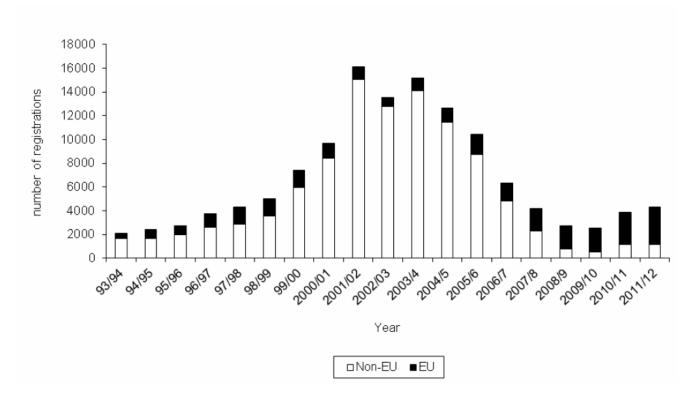
Outflow

- verifications reported to the NMC when a nurse applies to be registered in another country
- Measures an intention to nurse in another country rather than an actual geographical move, some double counting and outflow of foreign nationals returning post-education

Admission to the UK nursing register from EU and non-EU countries, 1993/4 to 2011/12

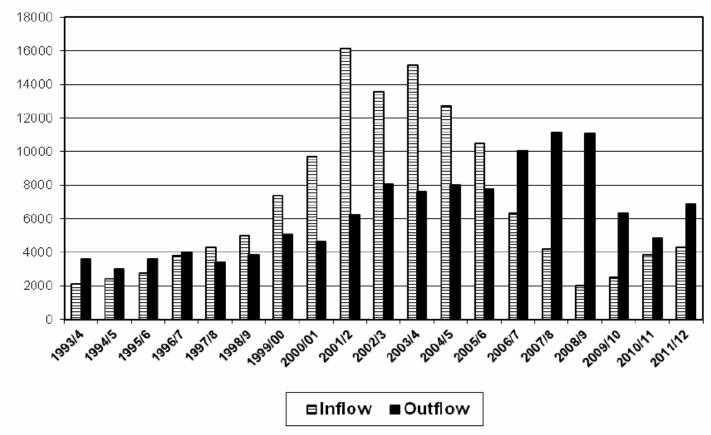

Proxy measures of inflow and outflow of nurses from the UK, 1993 to 2012



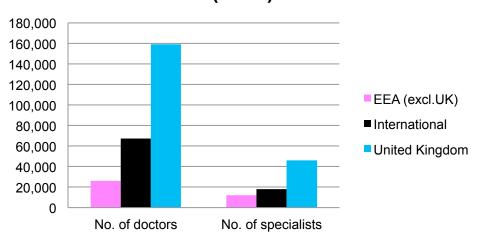

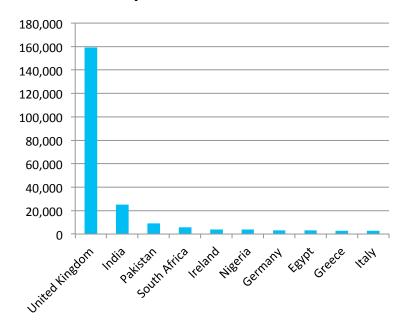
