



# Results, terminology 2

#### What kind of definition(s) are used?

- EC Feasibility Study: JQ, OECD, Eurostat, WHO (p24), WHO, ILO, OECD, Eurostat (p19)
- Health Prometheus: refers to Eurostat, Directive 2005/36/EC, uses Methodological explanatory note in course of data collection p18


- Nurses in advanced roles (OECD Working Paper 54, 2010):
- Different definitions of advanced role nursing are introduced (member states)
- Definition proposed by ICN (International Council of Nurses)



# Results, terminology 3

#### Terminology gap analysis (Y/N)

#### **ECAB**:

Yes, regarding the terminology differences in registration, licensing and revalidation/CME

# Nurses in advanced roles (OECD Working Paper 54, 2010)

Difficulties in providing a concise and clear definition, as this term encompasses a wide variety of competencies and practices. It makes the situation more difficult that some countries are more developed in implementing advanced roles than others, so the same practice can be considered advanced in one country and no longer in the other.


