KICK-OFF MEETING - JOINT ACTION EU HWF

Ladies & Gentlemen,

Over the course of the day, you have been reminded of the challenges that our generation and future generations will have to deal with regarding healthcare workers. We all know that these challenges cannot be tackled by diverging policies.

Planning is one part of the effort that is needed to manage these human resources issues. We need to know, make prognoses, and discuss the issues at local, EU, and World level. Since the Green paper and the BE-Presidency Conference in 2010, many countries have expressed their interest in going further than local prognosis and local policymaking. Europe offers us a chance to align policies without disregarding those local needs. By co-financing this Joint Action, the Executive Agency for Health & Consumers helps the Union and our different Governments to progress through the delivery of tangible added value for the policy makers.

I would like to thank the Executive Agency for providing us with their support during the preparation of this Joint Action.

Today was a good example of what the world should be: a gathering of like-minded people with goodwill working together, major international bodies promoting a complex piece of work that will influence our future.
