Contents of the workshop

- ▶ The focus will be on the planning process and forecasting models in use in our partners' Country.
- ▶ We will start presenting and discussing our methodology based on the content of feasibility study of the OECD document, on the review of forecasting models in 17 countries, and the review of existing literature.
- ▶ We will ask to the participants to share their experience and knowledge of their own Countries on this matter. In particular we would like to go in depth distinguishing, in the different Countries, between "planning processes" (actors involved, objectives, procedures, law aspects, stakeholders, strengths and weaknesses) and "forecasting models", if existing (projection period, professions in focus, drivers and indicators used in the models, results of the forecasting, eventually failures and successes of the forecasting).
- ▶ We will split the participants into two separate focus groups: one on forecasting models and the second one on planning processes.
- ▶ At the end we will meet everybody in a final plenary session.

- ▶ You can find the taxi station just outside the Arrival zone (€ 30/40, depends on traffic).

By train and bus

(1 hour and 30 minutes)

- ▶ Take Leonardo Express train to Termini Station (€ 14) or the FL1 train to Rome and stop at Ostiense Station (€ 8).
- ▶ Take the subway B Line – direction Laurentina – and stop at EUR Palasport station (ticket €1,50).
- ▶ Take the bus 777 and stop in Viale Oceano Pacifico corner to Viale Avignone (ticket €1,50).
