Prof. Valentin Ignatov, MD, PhD graduated the Higher Medical Institute of Varna in 1986. He acquired a specialty in surgery in 1995 and a Master's Degree in "Health Management" in 2012. He is a Director "Medical Diagnostic and Treatment Activities" at "St. Marina" University Hospital since 2014. In 2005 he acquired the scientific degree "Doctor" defending a dissertation entitled "Diagnostic and Curative Tactics and ND: Laser Therapy in Acute Bleeding from Gastric and Duodenal Ulcers". He specializes in the field of mini-invasive surgery - endoscopic and laparoscopic.
