Medical University-Plovdiv – basic facts and figures

- State high school accredited by the National Evaluation and Accreditation Agency
- Founded in 1945
- More than 35 000 local and foreign students from Europe, Asia, America, Africa
- 5 500 students (1 800 foreigners)
- 720 academic teachers (210 professors)
- Training in Bulgarian and in English
- Master degrees (medicine, dental medicine, pharmacy and health management) and bachelor degrees
- 127 PhD students
- Diplomas recognized by EC

Our Concept for Education, Research and Clinical Practice:




- To bring academic system to patient care and create the basis to translational medicine



Focus on Erasmus+ and students practice abroad

- Bilateral Erasmus agreements for academic exchange mobility with 96 universities from 22 countries
- We participate in Erasmus+ with tendency to extend European contract to non-European as well



- 57 participants (students and lecturers) from 9 countries
- Other non- Erasmus academic agreements for education: with medical universities and colleges from Israel (Hadassah), Ukraine (Zaporozhie), UK (London), Austria (Wien), Kazahstan (Karaganda), USA (Tennessy), Japan (Nagasaki)




Academic agreements aim to establish systemic connections with leading foreign universities and are sources of methodic, project and qualification help



Concluding remarks

- There are problems in education of medical doctors and specialists regarding international mobility exchange - lack of good English proficiency and non-formal restrictions in Erasmus+ program*
- A complex approach of academic activities is necessary to stimulate competence and motivation of health care specialists enrollment in PhD programs, enhancing mobility exchange, project involvement, edutainment...
