Clear framework to guide efforts

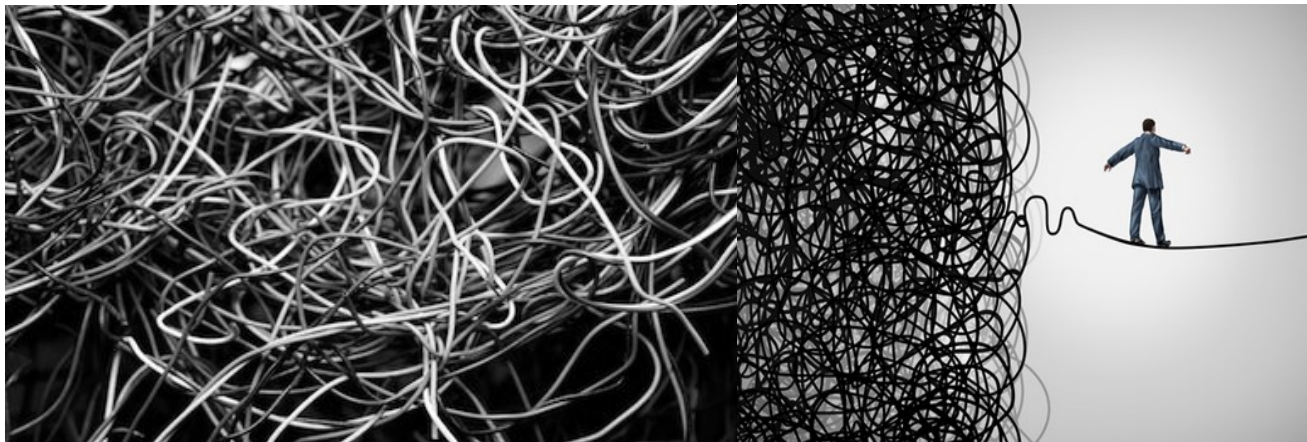
